**Minutes:** The minutes were approved as reflected in the web posting.

**Treasurers Report:** 2012 Report was available, 2013 proposed budget and envelopes for each Club from selling of ads from last year. More advertising is needed to be able to send dollars to the Hospital. A motion was made and seconded to accept the proposed budget. Motion passed.

**Committee Reports:**

**Queens-** Jeanne Kroker- Chosen by Oregon Cheerleaders Association- head coach, Sarah Deaveroux, was announced. Will have t-shirts with their names, like the FB players. Will be of no cost. Linn County Shrine Club will pay for the BBQ on Thursday night. Each Cheerleader will be asked to donate \$100 for their expenses. Cheerleaders made a donation to the Hospital after all their expenses. Will be staying at the Super 8. Possibility of having 2 cheerleaders who have been there for 4 years.

**Hospital-** Rodger Hood reported on attempting to get accurate numbers for meals at the Hospital.

**Program Sales-** Carey Huckaba reports it costs \$1000/player. Clubs need to get out and sell ads. Supports Shriners Hospital plus local players. Ads will be sent to the ad coordinator. **Form will be emailed out to the delegates and will be posted on the website in the near future.**

Business cards can be scanned and must meet the deadlines. Add more players per page to reduce costs. Advertising portion- our income has fallen in the past years and the businesses need a professional presentation. Includes a tri-fold brochure, letter, and DVD's which explains the mission of the Hospital, needs to be updated.

**Retail Sales-** Rodger Hood related that Dave Thomas will be doing the retail sales and will prep everything to get it ready to go. It was requested to have a selection of items at player pick up, which will be considered.
